The Foster Alliance

The Foster Alliance provides essentials like clothing, bedding, holiday gifts and birthday presents to children in foster care throughout Arizona. For the first time in Desert Financial history, all 1,300 of our team members volunteered together during our annual All Employee Event, where we assembled 430 bicycles for children in foster care.

Sharing & Caring Giving Campaign

Through our annual Sharing & Caring Giving Campaign, team members can pledge donations to one of our nine nonprofit partners for the upcoming year. Desert Financial matches each pledge, up to \$150 per person annually. In 2024, our team members donated \$528,493 to these nonprofits, and with Desert Financial's match, the total given was \$634,694.

Corporate giving

Our work to empower financial well-being is not limited to the financial education, products and services that individuals and communities need. These are critical aspects, but so are the basic human needs that support Arizonans in reaching for and achieving their financial hopes and dreams. 
